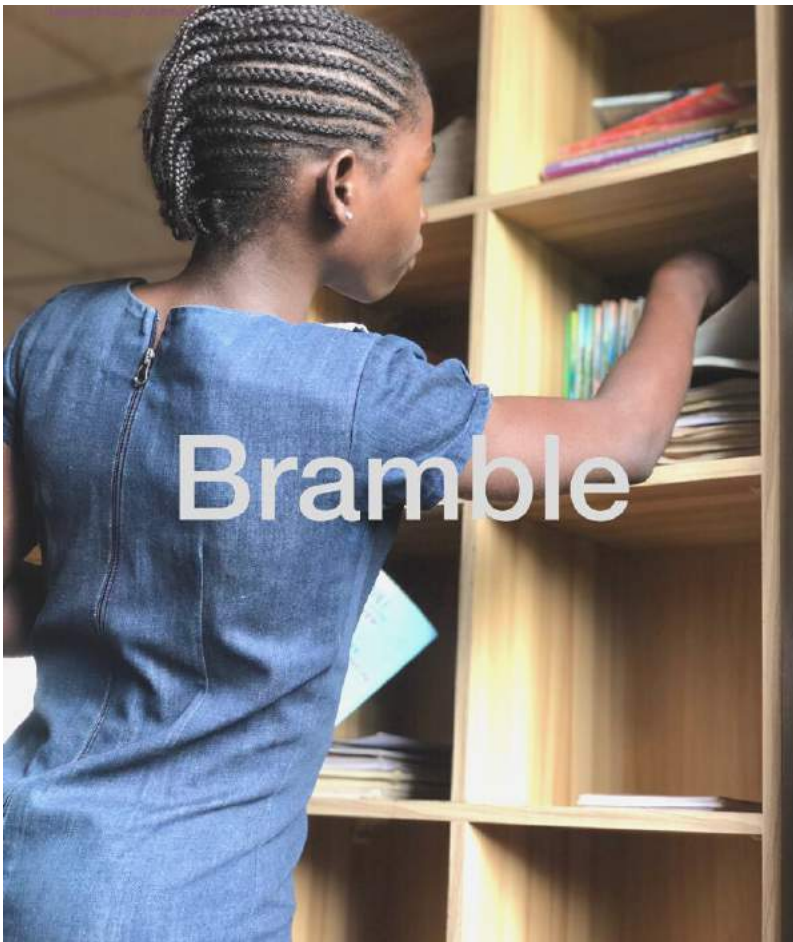

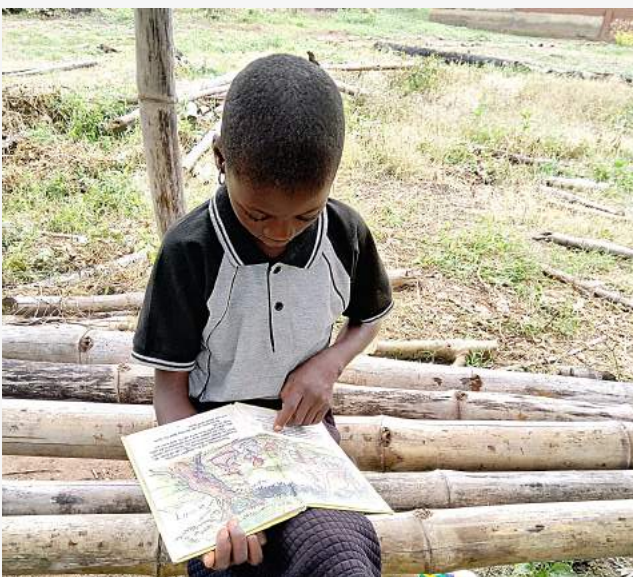
Her community gave her an award for her good character when she helped the king's wife find her missing purse. Mama Sade told Sade to imitate Mimi's character.
