Inauguration of Student Representative Council, SRC Members

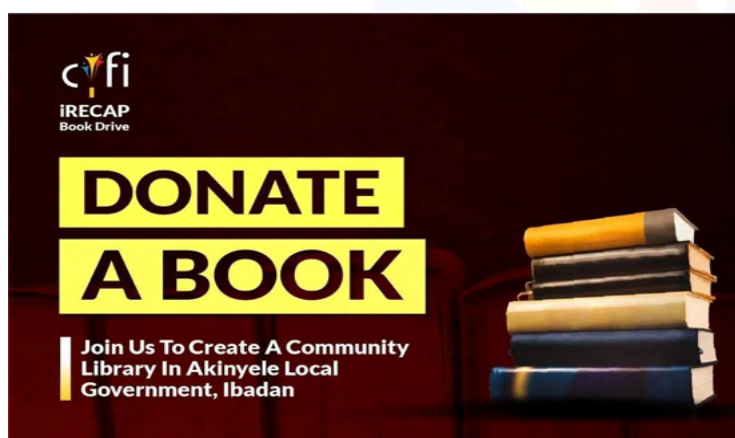
Annually, it is our culture at the learning space to elect representative among our learners. This we do to instill leadership skills in them. This January, Ola Elizabeth, Daniel

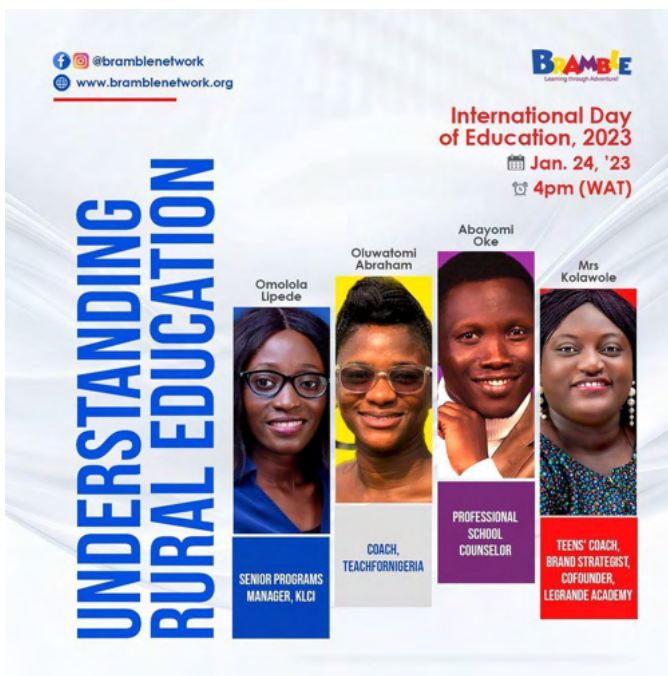
Bramble Innovation Hub Created Job Opportunities For Her Alumni Community

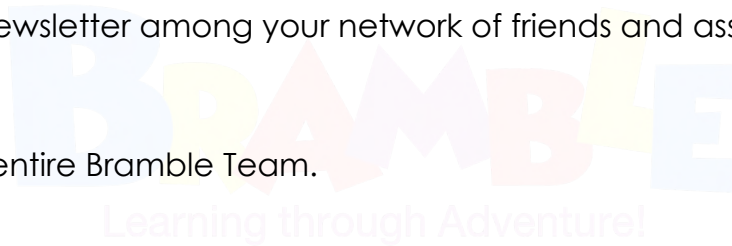
